## About Ragged Mountain

This 1300' coastal mountain is a conservation area open to the public for summer and winter trail use. The mountain and its trails are managed by four different organizations. Coastal Mountains Land Trust manages the Bald and Ragged Mountain Preserves, conservation easement land, the Hosmer Brook and Bald Mountain Trails, and the Round the Mountain Trail (RTM).
